The Regional Executive Meeting was held, Friday night, February 27, 2009.

Kevin Milton, NCCC Parliamentarian, heads the RE meeting each time. He was also nominated and elected the Chairperson for each meeting.

NCCC had projected a \$47,000 loss for the year 2008 ended up with a \$38,916 profit being shown.
