- 1. 85% of clubs voted on the National Meeting Site St. Louis will be the site 2013-2015.
- 2. \$1,000 budget was authorized for developing an Electronic Ballot for National Election of Officers.
- 3. Under Brown & Brown Insurance: 2 insurance claims were made. 1 was paid, 1 was denied. If a club has a Club Trailer it is covered under the insurance only when it is use at a club sponsored event. It is not covered in storage or traveling to or from the club sponsored event. A FAQ on insurance is being developed for the NCCC Website. An email blast will notify everyone when it is up. A roadside assistance program is being looked into. The cost will be anywhere from \$15 - \$45 a year for an NCCC member. As well as roadside assistance, it will have automotive and travel discounts in the package. Netsafe is the company, they cover AAA customers. More details will follow once program is completely developed.
- 4. Convention 2011 in Tinley Park is coming together and the financial outlook is very positive. Convention 2012 in Topeka, Kansas is moving very quickly and has no roadblocks. Convention 2013 in Bowling Green, Kentucky will be June 24 28, 2013.
