#### Please make sure your club members have access to this information:

- March applications are sent or given out at the first governor's meeting....Governors, if you need one and don't have internet access to the website, please contact me via postal mail at: 331 Riverside Drive, San Marcos, Texas 78666 or for questions call: (512) 392-4285
- 2. **June 15** POSTMARKED the last day for accepting applications
- 3. July 1 review applications and send letters to those receiving scholarships
- 4. August 1 mail checks to the scholarship recipients (approximately)

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Students interested in the region's scholarship program should understand that this award is for one year at a time, and must be renewed each year for the following academic year. The student must also understand what is required to be eligible for a scholarship award. Should the student meet the following requirements then he/she should contact their Governor, check your club's newsletter, or go to the Southwest Regional Web Site at: <a href="www.ncccswregion.org">www.ncccswregion.org</a>. #### **Scholarship Qualification Requirements:**

The applicant must show an ongoing association with NCCC for a minimum of **three years**, either as an NCCC member or a legal member of the immediate family of an NCCC member, and **submit a letter** from your governor stating that you are an active member having participated **in at least five (5)** club or regional events last year.

**High School** – **they must** have graduated (or will graduate this June) with an overall GPA (Grade Point Average on a 4 point system) of not less than 2.75

College Undergraduate – students must have an overall GPS of not less than 2.75

**Graduate** – students must have an undergraduate GPS of 2.75 overall (if just beginning graduate school) and at least 3.00 in all graduate work

**Occupational School** – students must have a scholastic standing in the top third of the class or what equates to a 2.75 GPA.

Applicant must <u>demonstrate financial need;</u> and the applicant must be able to <u>articulate their career</u> goals.

Applicant must supply a letter of acceptance from the institution for which the scholarship is to be awarded.

Please also note your club affiliation in your articulation statement.

Must be Postmarked on or before June 15<sup>th</sup> ...this is the last day for accepting applications.
