 - Regional Champions (club) Regional Champion – will add place on the patch
- 2017 Sanctioned Event Review
 - Record Drag Race index updates – Doug & Dale have been working on the 1/8th mile record indexes. We will use a .64 factor for ¼ vs 1/8th Mile ...man's & woman's will be same – we will finalize and send to Walt next week.
 - Record Drag Events
 - ¼ mile – Sunday, May 28 – Noble OK
 - 1/8 mile – September 3rd – Pacific Junction (south of Omaha) - Cornhusker
 - ¼ mile – Sunday, Oct 22 – Noble OK
