Hospitality Break: (8:00- 8:30)

- 2019/2020 Rulebook
 - Friday Sanctions (East Region) – to allow clubs to host events on Friday evening. RCD's discussed this and there wasn't enough interest; consider it a dead Issue – it was dropped
 - "Race" Language (Michigan Region) – discussed removing the word race in a couple of sections; concern is around the participant's insurance company and them participating in such an event. It was the concensus of the committee that anyone in the event that has a timed session and scores will be known as a race event even without the wording. Dale will search and see how many.
 - Number of competitors per car (East Ohio Region) – the rulebook is almost contradicting itself. Currently you can't have 3 of a single sex; you can only have 2 of one sex and 1 of the other – or you can have two couples (Male / Female). Dale will look at the wording and come up with something for the proposed rule change; possibly something as simple as:
 - Only two (2) drivers NCCC Members per car per class, with a maximum of two (2) male drivers and two (2) female drivers per car, will be allowed at a NCCC sanctioned event.
 - Class change for Group I in case of rain (Roadrunner Region) – change to rain tires for a safety reasons – want to allow changing. Dale will wordsmith and bring back up in September. The issue is that if you had a car that had non-DOT tires putting them in Grp 3, they would be re-classed to 1S when they went to treaded rain tires. We need to be careful when wording this so that people can't

just change (after Tech) to switch classes for benefit. The end-game wording needs to be good for all groups for safety reasons. Most likely it will be up to the RCD and/or Hosting Chairperson to determine "wet / dry conditions"

- We have moved the Forms out of Rule Book so they can be modified as needed during the year; will require a vote with the next rule book vote.
- RCD Roundtable
 - SWR - Doug:
 - 2 events completed – 1 complete in DB
 - 15 HS issued and 1 Denied
 - Mother's Day Weekend – High Speed at Hallett – we need participation
 - Record Drags (3 events) in Noble Memorial Weekend; 7 XCrosses on Saturday
 - Doug will share the URL to so RCDs can play with the new Membership Card and talk about it within their regions. This is a temporary way of viewing – most likely it will end up an option on the Member-Only Page.
 - Wireless Timing (Axware) Printing – contact me if you would be interested in a good long-distance solution which we implemented last weekend at TMS
 - Talk with your clubs about posting pictures to social media. Some are not cautious and getting folks in trouble with insurance companies ...since they are posting pictures with license plates.
 - Most RCD's discussed their upcoming events.
 - Check out WIX – some clubs are using this used to create an host club websites.
