Lots of History & Fun to be had in the Fort Worth Stockyards – Make a Weekend of it!



<u>Billy Bob's Texas</u> - Billy Bob's Texas is the world's largest honky-tonk. This place is huge (three acres!), with its own indoor rodeo arena for professional bull riding, a Texas-size dance floor, dozens of bar stations, plus restaurants, arcade games, a Wall of Fame with celebrity handprints, and a general store. It is also an amazing 10-time winner of country music's "Club of the Year."

<u>Cattle Drive twice daily</u> – 11:30 am and 4:00 pm – FREE – The Old West comes to life before your eyes during the Fort Worth Herd's twice-daily cattle drive. Genuine Texas cowhands drive a herd of Texas Longhorn Cattle down Exchange Avenue <u>Cowtown Cattlepen Maze</u> – find your way out of the 5,400 square foot maze <u>Cowtown Coliseum</u> - The Cowtown Coliseum located in the heart of the Fort Worth Stockyards has a rich history steeped in Rodeo and the West. The Cowtown Coliseum offers all the modern amenities, yet retains the feel of a historic site.



<u>Cowtown Opry</u> – Sunday at 2:00 pm. Cowtown Opry is a group of performers mighty proud of the great musical heritage of Texas!

<u>Cowtown Winery</u> – Cowtown Winery is one of Fort Worth's few full production wineries. Located in the Historic Fort Worth Stockyards, surround yourself with age old history in our 70+ year old location.

<u>Fort Worth Stockyards Adventure</u> – or do it all with this new, self-guided adventure includes a guided Stockyards Historic Walking Tour, a souvenir photo taken on the bull at Billy Bob's Texas – the world's largest honky-tonk – admission to the Texas Cowboy Hall of Fame and Stockyards Museum and more.

<u>Grapevine Vintage Steam Engine Train</u> – an authentic 1920's Victorian coach trip along the historic Cotton Belt Route.

<u>Pawnee Bill's Wild West Show</u> – A historical reenactment of the original Pawnee Bill's Wild West Show. Saturday at 4:30 pm & Sunday at 2:30 pm.

<u>Stockyards Museum</u> - The Stockyards Museum showcases the rich history of the Fort Worth Stockyards and the north side of Fort Worth

<u>Stockyard Horseback Riding</u> – Take a relaxing ride down the Old Chisholm Trail. <u>Stockyard Segway Tours</u> – This world-class Segway Fort Worth Stockyards Tour begins at the beautiful River Ranch Stockyards event venue where you will enjoy Segway orientation and training by a certified Segway (PT) tour professional.

<u>Texas Cowboy Hall of Fame</u> – honors those men and women who have excelled in the sport and business of rodeo, and the western lifestyle in Texas.



There are numerous other activities around the Stockyards, including souvenirs, petting zoo, walking tours, mechanical bull riding, old time photos, photo on a longhorn, take a ride in an authentic stage coach, not to mention there are a dozen or so historic Bars / Saloons.
