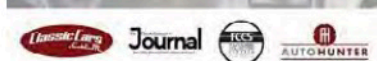
NCCC Renewals are rolling along. If you have not paid your dues for 2024, be sure to get to your club or contact the Regional Membership Director.

and won 3 times on Sunday at the dragstrip.

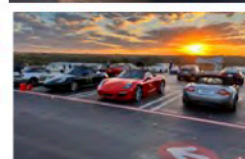
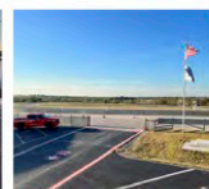
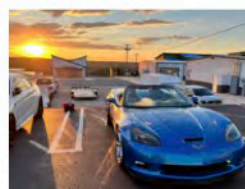

2. If you have purchased more than 1 hand you MUST DESIGNATE which sheet will be scored BEFORE drawing a chip.
3. The cards will be poker chips that have the value of a playing card on the back.
4. Chips will be blind drawn from a bag containing all available chips. Once drawn and recorded the chip will be returned to the bag before the next draw.
5. Your first chip will be drawn when you register, and the value will be recorded on your sheet with the official's initials.
6. The second chip will be drawn at the first scheduled stop, and the value will be recorded on your sheet with the official's initials.
7. The third card will be drawn at the second scheduled stop, and the value will be recorded on your sheet with the official's initials.
8. The fourth card will be drawn at the third scheduled stop, and the value will be recorded on your sheet with the official's initials.
9. The hand will be ranked using the chart below.
10. Winner walks away with 50% of the pot.
11. 2nd and 3rd best hands will receive prizes
